Expectations

Students are expected to come to class ready to learn. Students will use their time wisely in class. They will learn by listening to instruction, helping each other, conferencing with the teacher, working in learning centers, using technology, working in groups.

Students will learn through the Common Core standards in each subject. These learning goals outline what each student should know and be able to do at the end of each grade. Students are also taught with our Schoolwide Learning Expectation (SLEs).

Students need to have all supplies ready for use. Each Friday students will take home their supply pouches to make sure everything is in good order for the following week.

Homework is sent home daily. Incomplete HW slips will be sent home if HW is missing. HW will be completed at recess/lunch/home. You may request HW in advance if your child will be absent.

Expectations/Discipline

Chapel Star: An excellent assignment is chosen to be displayed for a month.

Student of the Month: Students that demonstrate the monthly character trait are chosen.
