### RE-REGISTRATION AT CCS 1/29 – 3/3

Siblings who will be 5 years old by September 1, 2023 are eligible to register for Kindergarten! Please contact the school office for an appointment for testing!

Re-registration will take place from January 29 -March 3. Your reregistration forms will be enclosed in your next Family Envelope. These forms must be completed and returned to school no later than Friday, March 3 with the annual fee of \$375.00 and the re-registration fee of \$25.00. Please be advised that this fee of \$400.00 is non-refundable. We will be testing new students for grades 2 - 7 on Wednesday, March 15 and students for grades K - 1 on Saturday, March 11, 2023. It is very important that we know how many of our present students plan to return for the 2023 -2024 school year so we can accept the new students who want to attend CCS. If you know families who would like to send their students to CCS, please ask them to phone the school office for an application and an appointment for testing. If you know at this time that you are not returning to CCS in August 2023, please notify the office as soon as possible. Thank you for your cooperation and support of CCS! •

#### FRIENDLY REMINDERS REGARDING UNIFORM POLICY FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES K - 8

Students may wear solid white, navy blue or black socks that can be seen above the shoes. Other colors or patterned socks are not acceptable! Girls may also wear white, navy blue or black knee high socks or tights! Girls MAY NOT WEAR LEGGINGS as part of the school uniform!

Students will receive a uniform infraction which will affect their behavior grades if they are not in proper school uniform. Girls may not wear nail polish to school. They will be sent to the office to remove it by the classroom teacher.

Shoes for all students must be WHITE, NAVY BLUE OR BLACK!
